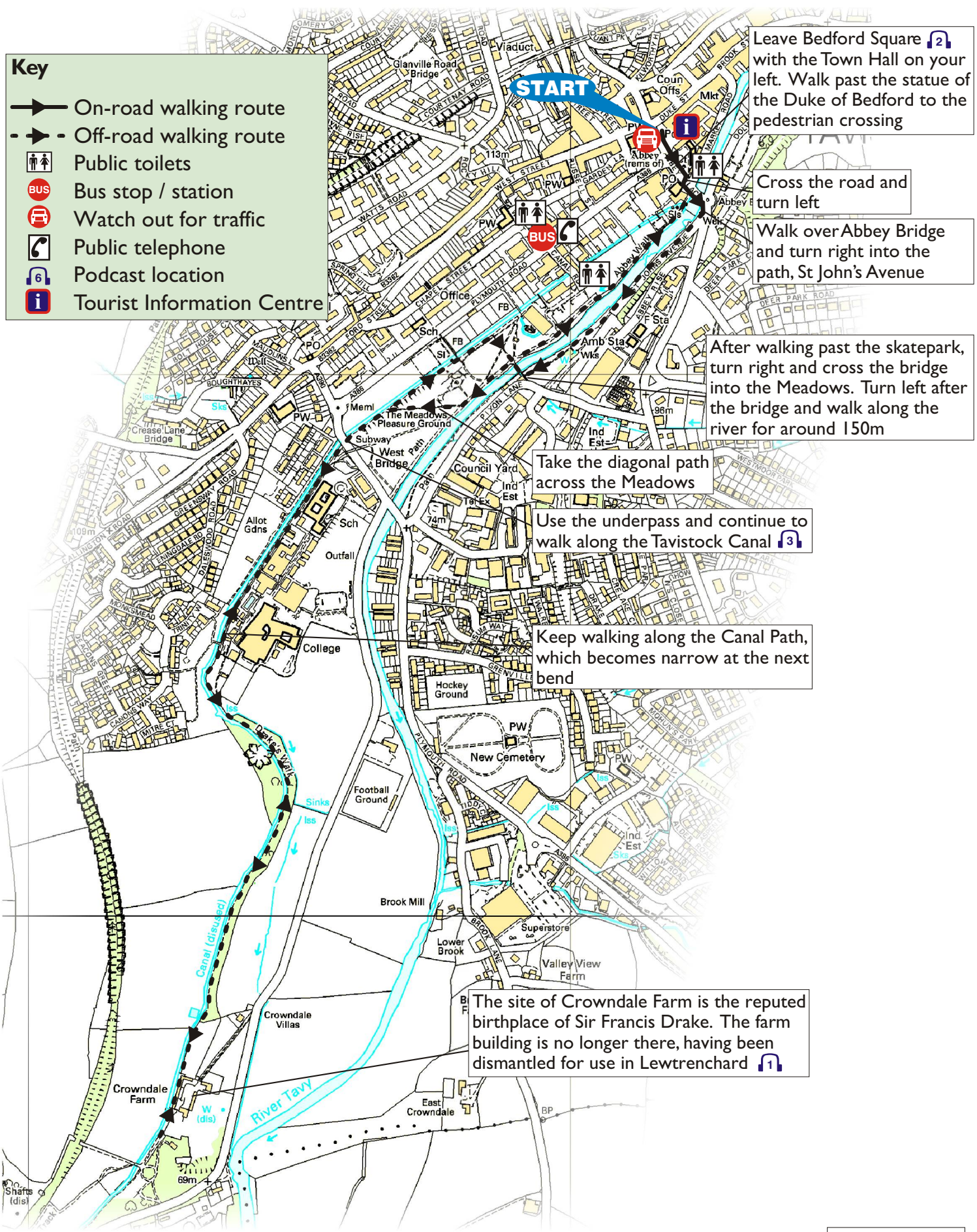


# Walking Spur 4 - Tavistock to Crowndale

**Key**

Leave Bedford Square with the Town Hall on your left. Walk past the statue of the Duke of Bedford to the pedestrian crossing

Cross the road and turn left

Walk over Abbey Bridge and turn right into the path, St John's Avenue

After walking past the skatepark, turn right and cross the bridge into the Meadows. Turn left after the bridge and walk along the river for around 150m

Take the diagonal path across the Meadows

Use the underpass and continue to walk along the Tavistock Canal

Keep walking along the Canal Path, which becomes narrow at the next bend

The site of Crowndale Farm is the reputed birthplace of Sir Francis Drake. The farm building is no longer there, having been dismantled for use in Lewtrenchard
